### Joy Full

(Galatians 5:22-23) "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is now law."

✓ **Chara (NT Greek) - The joy \_\_\_\_\_; the \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ of joy.**

(John 15:4-5; 10-11 NLT) "Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful apart from me. Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit...When you obey me, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father and remain in his love. I have told you this so that you will be **filled with my joy**. Yes, **your joy will overflow!**"

### Joy Full

#### ✓ Chara (NT Greek) - The joy **RECEIVED**; the **CAUSE** or **SOURCE** of joy.

(John 15:4-5; 10-11 NLT) "Remain in me, and I will remain in you. For a branch cannot produce fruit if it is severed from the vine, and you cannot be fruitful apart from me. Yes, I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit...When you obey me, you remain in my love, just as I obey my Father and remain in his love. I have told you this so that you will be **filled with my joy**. Yes, **your joy will overflow!**"

### 3 Sources of Limited Joy

#### ✓ **PROMOTION**

#### ✓ **POSITION**

#### 2. Serve **OTHERS**.

(Matthew 22:39 NLT) "A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

(Matthew 20:28a NLT) "For even I, the Son of Man, came here not to be served but to serve others..."

#### 3. Give of **YOURSELF**.

(Matthew 20:28b NLT) "...and to give my life as a ransom for many."

(John 15:23 NLT) "My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you."
